Submission Guideline for Author/s-

1. All submissions must be word-processed, double-spaced in Times New Roman, font size 12 and justified. The prescribed word limit (3000-4000) is inclusive of footnotes and student contributors are expected to strictly conform to them.
2. Only footnotes may be used as the form of citations. All footnotes must be in Times New Roman, size 10, single-spacing and justified. The Rules of Citation should be derived from The Bluebook, A Uniform System of Citation (19th Ed).
3. All submissions are expected to be published in a special issue of the Journal of Indian Law and Society in its Volume III Monsoon Issue. However, final publication will depend on an independent and anonymous peer review process which will be conducted by the journal.
