Presentation and End Semester). Mr. Manchanda had appeared in this paper as a repeater during the winter 2016 examination but the Academic Section received his project and end semester marks from the course teacher but his presentation marks was pending and his final result could not be published.

On 17th November 2017 he had informed Academic Section that he had sent the project directly to the course teacher (though the usual practice for students as per Academic rules to submit the project to the Academic Section and then the section forwards it to the concerned faculty) and thereafter the course teacher was requested to forward his marks on 29th November 2017 and again Mr. Manchanda's mail was forwarded to the course teacher on 4th December 2017 for submission of marks. On 6th December 2017 he was informed to contact his subject teacher at the earliest for giving his presentation without which he would not be able to get his degree in the 12th Convocation scheduled to be held on 10th December 2017.

On 7th December 2017 he informed that he had appeared for the presentation in his final year 10th semester alongwith his Corporate Insolvency presentation under the same course teacher and again a mail was forwarded to the course teacher for marks on 8th December 2017 but no marks forwarded by the course teacher. On 11 January 2018 Mr. Manchanda had requested for his degree and again the course teacher was sent a mail on 12th January 2018 for presentation marks. On 5th February 2018 Mr. Manchanda has informed that since the record of the previous presentation can be found the

course teacher has kindly allowed him to submit a new project and needs the approval to correct it. Since he had been suggested to get in touch with the course teacher directly he requested the Academic Section to expedite the process and submitted the new project with a copy to the course teacher. On 8th February 2018 he informed that he had submitted the project on 11th March 2016 and given his presentation on the next day (12th March 2016). On 9th February 2018 after getting permission from the then Vice-Chancellor, Prof. (Dr.) P. Ishwara Bhat, he contacted his course teacher and appeared for the presentation and the result of which was published on 26th April 2018 and later revised result was published on 11th May 2018. Now as his result was published in the year 2018, he is eligible to get degree in the year 2018 during the 13th Convocation.

However, Mr. Manchanda in his letter dated 4.1.2019 requested the Vice-Chancellor that as he had appeared for the viva along with his batch he is eligible for his degree in the year 2017. His application is attached herewith for your kind perusal
