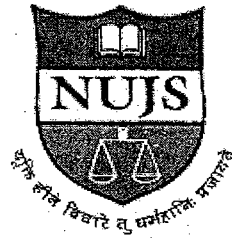

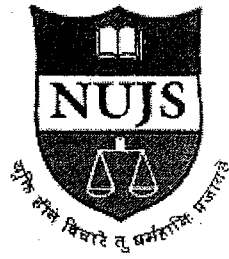

In addition to the confirmation of the minutes, the Treasurer of the University also proposed that the Finance Committee should meet at least once in three months for better coordination and planning.	
2.	Proposal for release of DA with enhanced rate i.e. 90% (increase of 10% ) w.e.f. 01.07.2013	<p>The Central Govt. has revised the Dearness Allowance from 80% to 90% w.e.f. 01.07.2013 and the same was notified by The Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India vide Office Memorandum O.M.No.1-8/2013-E-II(B) dated, New Delhi, the 25th September, 2013. In the event of its approval for release of DA with enhanced rate i.e. 90% (increase of 10%) to all NUJS employees with effect from 01.07.2013 the extra involvement of fund for payment of DA would be around Rs. 1.74 Lakhs(Approximately) per month with a total financial arrear liability of around Rs. 10.46 lakhs for the period 01.07.2013 – 31.12.2013 which is accommodated in 'the revised estimates of 2013-2014 under the head; "Salaries and Allowances".</p> <p><b><u>Resolution</u></b></p> <p>The Finance Committee accepted the proposal for enhancement of DA and directed that it can be paid now, and subsequently be reported to Executive Council. It was further resolved that dearness allowance is applicable only to the permanent employees of the University.</p>	
3.	Submission of Annual Accounts for the years 2003-2004 to 2012-13	<p>Dy. Accountant General of Govt. of Indian Audit &amp; Accounts Dept., Kol-1 has asked the University to submit the Annual Accounts of the University for the years from 2003-2004 to 2012-13 for conducting Audit of the said years which have fallen due. The matter was placed for direction.</p> <p><b><u>Resolution</u></b></p> <p>It is resolved that University would take necessary steps to facilitate audit by the Dy.</p>

4.	Proposal to revive the ICICI Bank Account	<p>An accounts of the University was maintained at the ICICI Bank, Salt Lake branch. When the Corporation Bank started functioning from the campus, all the accounts except in the name of M/s. "The WBNUJS Building Construction Account A/C" were closed. The account at ICICI has a fixed deposit of Rs. 9,23,158.00 Cr. and an operative balance of Rs. 5,541 as on 31st March 2013. At present the status of the accounts is dormant. In order to revive the account a resolution of the finance committee empowering Vice Chancellor and the Registrar of the University as joint signatories is required.</p> <p><b><u>Resolution</u></b></p> <p>The Finance Committee resolved that the WBNUJS Building Construction Account A/C maintained at ICICI Bank will be revived and all necessary steps may be taken for such revival. A calculation on the loss of interest in case of premature withdrawal of the fixed deposit may also be undertaken. The signatories for this account would be the Vice Chancellor and Registrar of WBNUJS.</p>	
5.	Proposal from Student Juridical Association for Funds to organize Alumni Meet of Past Students	<p>Student Juridical Association (SJA), WBNUJS is proposing to organize ALUMNI Meet on 23rd February 2014 in order to foster interaction between the current students and the previous batches for future endeavors benefiting the University. In order to host the meet SJA has requested the University to allocate Rs. 1.25 Lakh.</p> <p><b><u>Resolution</u></b></p> <p>The Finance Committee accepted the proposal for the Alumni Association Meet organize by SJA and resolved to fund the meet to the tune of Rs. 1.00 lakh without creating any precedence, and as one time measure.</p>	
6.	Release of Gratuity & Employers Provident Fund Contribution of Mr. Supriyo Routh, former faculty	<p>Mr. Supriyo Routh, Assistant Professor (Law) joined the university 26<sup>th</sup> June 2007 as Lecturer. Mr. Routh went on study leave for one year pursuing an LL.M. Course in clinical Legal Studies at Vanderbilt University from 01/08/2007 to 31/07/2008, three years for pursuing his Ph.D at the University of Victoria, Canada from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2009 to 30<sup>th</sup> August 2012 and further from 19/11/2012 till date the of resignation on June 2013. Subsequently his resignation was accepted on 44<sup>th</sup> E.C. meeting dated 14<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2013. The matter was placed before the finance committee whether he will be entitled to a (1) Gratuity (2) Employers Provident Fund Contribution, as per The NUJS Contributory Provident Fund cum Gratuity Rules</p>	

		<p><b><u>Resolution</u></b></p> <p>The Finance Committee decided that Mr. Supriyo Routh, Assistant Professor (Law) was ineligible for payment of 1) Gratuity (2) Employers Provident Fund Contribution, as per rules of "The NUJS Contributory Provident Fund cum Gratuity Rules". The Finance Committee directed that the resolution would be put up before the next Executive Council meeting and a letter communicating this decision to be made to the incumbent.</p>	
7.	Revision of Pay Structure for Accounts Officer & Assistant Registrar(Academics)	<p>With reference to the Govt. of West Bengal Order No. 78 - EDU (U) dated 23 February 2010, Mr. Gautam Pal, Accounts Officer has requested. for an initial revision of Grade Pay from Rs.7600/- to Rs.8000/- w.e.f. 28/04/2010 and after completion of three years of service, i.e. w.e.f. 28/04/2013 Pay Band IV needs to be implemented with a Grade pay of Rs.9000/-.</p> <p>Mr. Tapas Bhattacharya, Assistant Registrar(Academics) has requested that he is also eligible to get a Grade Pay of Rs.6000/- from Rs. 5400/- as per Govt. Order No. 78 - EDU (U) dated 23 February 2010 w.e.f. 11/09/2009. He has also requested for a Grade Pay of Rs.7000/- w.e.f. 11/09/2013 as four years of service is likely to be completed. Request from Adhoc Faculty Members for Annual Increment	<p>Ms. Sampa Karmakar Singh, Assistant Professor (Law) and Mr. Abhishek Mishra are the adhoc faculty members in the University serving against the leave vacancy in the pay scale of Rs 15,600 – 39,100 , Grade Pay 6000. Ms. Sampa Karmakar Singh &amp; Mr. Abhishek Mishra had served the University since January 2011 and February 2012 respectively with discontinuous tenures. Dear Prof Bhat:

I hope this finds you well. I've been forwarded a note by the Hon'ble Registrar, informing me that the Executive Council (EC) kindly agreed to grant my leave (without pay) with retrospective effect, on grounds of my fathers' terminal illness (cancer).

I am deeply indebted to the EC members for their compassionate decision, owing to which I was able to spend some quality time with my father and take care of him. Fortunately, he recovered well and is much better now.

I am particularly obliged to the EC members for arriving at this considerate decision, despite your misrepresentation to them on the work of the IP Chair. You had opposed my leave application on the alleged ground that no credible work was being done on the IP Chair. This, despite the fact that several documents submitted to your office more than amply indicated the range of high quality IP work (research, scholarship, policy and IP outreach) that was being undertaken on a continuous basis, my leave notwithstanding. As you are no doubt aware, the IP Chair was set up by the Ministry of HRD at various premier institutions including the National Law Schools, IIT's and IIM's to foster IP research, advanced IP teaching and to render high quality policy advice to the government from time to time. For the last 5 years of operation of the NUJS IP Chair, this has been done quite successfully, with the result that our chair is recognized as one of the leading IP chairs, with a reputation not only in India, but also abroad. The various annual reports submitted to your office and the Ministry of HRD bear ample testimony to this.

In fact, when I requested you for leave, I made it a point to mention that I would not let the activities of the IP Chair suffer in my absence, and would attend government meetings and engage in various other IP activities as far as possible. This was also on record in my email to you requesting for the leave. I attach this email for your kind reference.

Pursuant to that commitment, I made myself present in Delhi and various other places for government meetings whenever the occasion demanded, and as far as I could, throughout the tenure of my leave. In fact, as I began penning this email to you some days ago, I was in Chennai to render advisory services to the National Biodiversity Authority (NBA), a government agency with which I work extensively. I also engaged with University activities as best as I could and attended an Executive Council (EC) meeting at my own expense, whilst on leave.

Please note that all this was done on leave without drawing any salary whatsoever.

I attach an earlier email of yours, where you clearly indicated that you would support my application for leave. However, when the matter came up before the Executive Council (EC) meeting (which you chaired), you vehemently opposed my leave application, on the spurious ground that I had not performed and that no work was being done on the IP Chair.

I was extremely hurt and disillusioned with this misrepresentation and can no longer bring myself to trust you. I find no other reason for your stunning volte-face, than my constant questioning of your policies. As several of my colleagues at NUJS know, I had taken serious issue with the unhealthy opacity that you unleashed at NUJS after taking charge. I was appalled at the way in which earlier policies that catapulted NUJS to the top of the academic league were reversed without due discussion and deliberation with your faculty colleagues. I had, time and again, requested you to take stronger note of the fact that we were

losing top quality faculty and to initiate measures to stem this tide. In particular, I took issue with your refusal to grant a Skype interview to a very promising Indian scholar from the Netherlands, owing to which we effectively lost him to IIT Delhi. You will recollect that the Executive Council also took strong note of this and recommended that Skype interviews be granted to scholars who are unable to fly at short notice to Kolkata.

Time and again, I urged you to refrain from being vindictive towards faculty colleagues who were not in your good books, not least because I happened to be one of them. Despite the Increasing Diversity by Increasing Access (IDIA) project being incubated out of NUJS, you showed great hostility to the movement only because I founded it. Today, this movement to empower underprivileged communities through legal education has made great progress, with 28 underprivileged scholars that we trained studying at the various National Law Universities (NLU's). You refused to sign IDIA cheques, despite opinions from reputed tax experts in the country including leading senior counsel, Arvind Datar, who more than categorically opined that you could so sign without any impediment. This greatly hampered our operations and risked the future of several underprivileged scholars being trained by IDIA.

You then reversed an earlier policy initiated by Prof MP Singh that all IDIA scholars would be granted a fee waiver, if admitted to NUJS. You stipulated that only one IDIA scholar would be granted this waiver. As a result of this change in policy, we had to send two of our most promising scholars (who merited admission to NUJS) to NLU Delhi, where Prof Ranbir Singh, the Vice Chancellor, went out of his way to support these underprivileged scholars, including offering them a fee waiver and laptops.

After much thought and deliberation, I've decided that I cannot serve under your leadership anymore. Please treat this as my resignation letter, to take effect on the 6th of February, 2014.

I write this with a very heavy heart, given how much NUJS and its students meant to me and what an intellectual exhilarating journey it was to work under the leadership of stalwarts such as Professor MP Singh. One of my friends asked me if I ever regret having cut short a promising academic career abroad to return to India. I think it was the best choice I ever made, not least because I was able to participate in the growth of one of the most promising Indian institutions and work with an exceptional group of academics to help unleash a number of educational innovations. In many ways, while NLS, Bangalore signalled a revolutionary era in Indian legal education, NUJS took it to the next level with its dynamic emphasis on research, scholarship and advancing the frontiers of legal knowledge.

All of the petty politics and bureaucratic sluggishness that one encountered from time to time were more than made up by the passion, creativity and enthusiasm of our students, who are and will continue to remain our biggest asset. Borrowing a legendary line from a Bollywood classic (Deewar), my constant refrain has been: "Mere paas students hain".

I will miss my students dearly, as also my wonderful faculty colleagues and members of the administration and support staff, all of whom made my time at NUJS extremely memorable, treating me as one of their very own.

Since I am on leave now, I will join the University on January 6th to wind up all pending work on the IP Chair from my end. If you need me to extend this date, or if there is any other work you wish me to undertake in the interim, including helping you locate a successor for the IP Chair, please do let me know.

With the hope that NUJS will restore someday to its former glory and serve as a leading site for legal education and scholarship, I remain

WHEREBY it is mutually agreed between the parties hereto for themselves and their respective executors, administrators, assigns, or successors, as follows:

1. The PUBLISHERS shall produce and publish at their own risk and expense, within a reasonable time after delivery by the EDITORS of the complete manuscript acceptable to the PUBLISHERS and ready for the printer, the WORK at present entitled ***Economic Challenges for the Contemporary World: Essays in Honour of Prabhat Patnaik (TNF)*** (hereinafter termed the WORK).
2. The signatories to this Agreement hereby certify that they have full rights to enter into this Agreement, and that the 17 contributors have specifically empowered them to enter into this Agreement with the PUBLISHERS, to retain copyright in the WORK, and to receive all royalties and other monies due under the terms of this Agreement. The EDITORS will secure, and furnish to the PUBLISHERS in original, individual copyright assignment forms from all contributors to the WORK in accordance with the proforma supplied by the PUBLISHERS.
3. The EDITORS agree to deliver to the publisher no later than on the date indicated in Clause 19 below, a typescript of the WORK acceptable to the PUBLISHERS in form, content and length. The EDITORS undertake that the final typescript will not exceed **1, 20,000 (One Hundred Twenty Thousand)** words in length. The PUBLISHERS reserve the right to have the final typescript of the WORK evaluated and the EDITORS agree to incorporate any changes, revisions and additions suggested by the PUBLISHERS' reader in the WORK, subject to mutual consultation between the EDITORS and the PUBLISHERS. In the event that the EDITORS fail to deliver the typescript of the WORK on the stipulated date or in a form or content acceptable to the PUBLISHERS or if the EDITORS indicate inability to carry out any revisions or changes or to incorporate any additions which are considered essential by the PUBLISHERS' reader, then the PUBLISHERS reserve the right to cancel this Agreement.
4. The EDITORS hereby warrant to the PUBLISHERS that the WORK shall be in no way whatever a violation of any existing copyright and that it shall contain nothing obscene, objectionable, indecent, or of a libellous or scandalous character or nature, and that the EDITORS will indemnify the PUBLISHERS against loss, injury or damage (including any legal costs or expenses properly incurred) occasioned to the PUBLISHERS in consequence of any breach by the EDITORS (unknown to the PUBLISHERS) of this warranty.
5. The PUBLISHERS shall, during the legal term of copyright, have the exclusive right to produce and publish the WORK in book form throughout the world.
6. The EDITORS shall not arrange for the publication, otherwise than by the PUBLISHERS or with their permission in writing, of any abridgement or expansion or of any substantial part of the WORK or of any other work of a nature likely to compete with the WORK which is the subject of this Agreement.

7. The EDITORS hereby grants to the PUBLISHERS, during the continuance of this Agreement, exclusive licences of the subsidiary rights listed below and the PUBLISHERS undertake to pay the EDITORS the following percentage of the net sums received by the PUBLISHERS in respect of such rights:

(a) Dramatisation, Stage Production, Broadcasting, Television	50%
(b) Anthology, Quotation and Course Packs	50%
(c) Digest and Condensation	50%
(d) Serial rights before publication in book form:	100%
i) Where sold before signature of this Agreement	50%
ii) Where sold after signature of this Agreement	50%
(e) Serial rights subsequent to publication in book form	50%
(f) One-shot periodical or newspaper rights	50%
(g) Reprint rights licensed to another publisher	50%

8. The PUBLISHERS shall have the exclusive rights to publish, if they so desire, on the terms of this Memorandum of Agreement, translations or adaptations of the original text of the WORK in any general or regional language throughout the world, charging the fees and/or royalties payable to the Translators or Adaptors against the royalties payable to the EDITORS on the sales of the said translations or adaptations. Should the PUBLISHERS signify in writing their refusal to publish a translation or adaptation of the WORK in any language or dialect, the EDITORS shall then, subject to agreement with the PUBLISHERS as to terms, be at liberty to arrange elsewhere for a translation or adaptation in that particular language or dialect. Where the PUBLISHERS license the translation rights to another publisher, whether in or outside India, the PUBLISHERS undertake to pay the EDITOR 50% (fifty per cent) of the net sums received by the PUBLISHERS in respect of such rights.

Except that in the event that the Publishers, at their sole discretion, enter into a Co-Publishing arrangement with another Publisher for publishing an adaptation of the original text in an Indian regional language, the Publishers undertake to pay the EDITOR 10% (ten percent) of the net sum received, from time to time, by the Publisher. In such a case all fees or expenses payable to the Translators or Adaptors shall be the liability of the Publishers/Co-Publishers.

9. The disposal of any rights not specified in Clauses 4, 5, 6, and 7 hereof shall be a matter of mutual agreement between the EDITORS and the PUBLISHERS.
10. The copyright of the WORK shall remain the property of the EDITORS who hereby empower the PUBLISHERS to take, in the EDITORS' names but at the PUBLISHERS' expense, any action, legal or otherwise, that the PUBLISHERS may consider necessary to protect their rights under this Agreement.
11. The PUBLISHERS shall have the entire control of the format of the WORK and of its jacket/cover and shall be at liberty to make any corrections or alterations in the original text as may seem to them advisable in the interest of the WORK. All decisions as to the production, manufacturing materials, publication, advertising, price, and terms of sale of the WORK shall be made by the PUBLISHERS at their sole discretion.

12. If, in the opinion of the PUBLISHERS and the EDITORS, illustrations are desirable, the EDITORS shall, unless otherwise mutually agreed, supply to the PUBLISHERS, or obtain for the PUBLISHERS' use, with the written permission of the copyright-owner, free of charge and copyright fee, suitable photographs, pictures, diagrams, graphs, drawings, maps and other material for illustrating the WORK. Such material supplied by the EDITORS shall remain the property of the EDITORS or copyright-owner and shall be returned when finished with to the EDITORS or copyright-owner, if so required, but the PUBLISHERS shall not be liable for accidental damage thereto or for loss thereof in the absence of negligence on their part or on the part of their employees.
13. The EDITORS agree to supply the PUBLISHERS with an index, or bear the cost of making one, if in the opinion of the EDITORS and/or PUBLISHERS an index is desirable, and to edit and revise, if necessary, every subsequent edition of the WORK; but in the event of the EDITORS neglecting or being unable to do so by reason of death or otherwise, the expense of revising and preparing each such future edition for press shall be borne by the EDITORS.
14. The EDITORS undertake to read, check and correct the proofs of the WORK and shall return them to the PUBLISHERS within a reasonable time of their receipt failing which the publishers may consider the proofs as passed for press. The PUBLISHERS shall deduct from any sums due to the EDITORS under the terms of this Agreement, all cost of EDITORS' corrections and alterations in proof-sheets exceeding 10% (ten per cent) of the cost of composition of the WORK.
15. During the legal term of copyright of the WORK the EDITORS shall receive collectively the royalties set out below:
- (a) From the Publishers: Except those specified in Clause 14(b), a Royalty of 10% (ten per cent) of net sales of all copies (print and e-version) sold in India
  - (b) From the Publisher's Affiliates: A Royalty of 10% (ten per cent) on net sales (print and e-version) by PUBLISHERS' Group Companies in the United States of America (USA) and United Kingdom (UK).
16. In the event of any copies of the WORK being sold off as remainders at more than cost, the PUBLISHERS shall pay to the EDITORS 10% (ten per cent) of the net receipts from such sales. If copies are sold off as remainders at cost or less than cost, no payment shall be made to the EDITORS. The EDITORS will be entitled to purchase a few copies for their personal use at the remainder price.
- The PUBLISHERS shall destroy stocks of the WORK, or sell it off as pulp, after informing the EDITORS of their intention and offering the EDITORS a few copies for personal use.
17. Accounts shall be made up annually covering the financial year 1 April to 31 March, delivered by the thirtieth day of the following June and settled by cheque or its equivalent with the account
18. The EDITOR of the WORK shall receive 6 (six) presentation copies of the WORK on publication and one complimentary copy each for the first contributor of the papers included.



All mailing charges for sending the complementary copies to the contributors would be debited to the royalties due to the EDITOR.

19. If the PUBLISHERS fail to fulfil or comply with any of the provisions of this Agreement within one month after written notification from the EDITORS of such failure; or if an order is made or an effective resolution passed for the liquidation of the PUBLISHERS, other than a voluntary liquidation for the purpose of reconstruction only; or if after the WORK is out of print they have not within six months of a written request from the EDITORS issued a new edition or impression -- then and in any of these events this Agreement shall automatically terminate without prejudice to any claim which the EDITORS may have either for monies due and/or damages and/or otherwise.
20. The EDITORS shall deliver to the PUBLISHERS the manuscript of the WORK complete in all respects and ready for the printer by **30 June 2014**.
21. The EDITORS agree that any fees paid by the PUBLISHERS for the drawings, graphs, charts, maps and other material for illustrating the WORK which the PUBLISHERS have prepared with the EDITORS' consent for inclusion in the WORK, shall be charged against and deducted from any sums herein due to the EDITORS. All such material shall, on recovery of its cost by the PUBLISHERS, be the property of the EDITORS and shall be given to them, when finished with, if so required, but the PUBLISHERS shall not be liable for accidental changes thereto or for loss thereof, in the absence of negligence on their part or on the part of their own employees.
22. The construction, validity and performance of this Agreement shall be governed in all respects by Indian law as in force in the Union Territory of Delhi. In case of any difference or dispute arising between the parties hereto concerning the various provisions of the Agreement, the same shall be submitted to arbitration by a sole arbitrator who will be mutually acceptable to the parties hereto. Such arbitration will take place in accordance with the provisions of the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 as amended from time to time.
