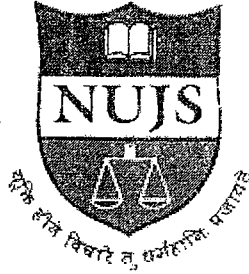

1.	Confirmation of the minutes of the 62 nd meeting of the Finance Committee held on 1 st December 2011.	<p>The members of the Finance Committee welcomed the new Vice Chancellor, Professor Dr. P. Ishwara Bhat to the meeting.</p> <p>The Minutes of the 62nd meeting of the Finance Committee held on 1st December 2011 were confirmed with the following observations:</p> <p>In regard to Agenda Item no:2.;the Vice Chancellor clarified the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. The recruitments being made for the proposed two year M.Phil course will actually cost the University Rs.36 Lakhs(Approx) annually in terms of disbursement of pay to the employees recruited for teaching the course. b. In terms of the new UGC regulations the demand for enrollment in M.Phil courses have gone down since regulations permit taking of the UGC – NET exam instead of enrolment for the M.Phil course. <p>The Finance Committee in view of the Vice Chancellor's clarification resolved to refer the recruitment's for the two year M.Phil course in Law, Public Policy and Governance to the Executive Council for withholding such appointments.</p>	
2.	Proposal for enhancement of fees for the forthcoming batch of 2012 of the University.	<p>The University proposes to enhance its tuition fees for the forthcoming batch of 2012 of the University .</p> <p>Accordingly a detailed statement of the proposed enhancement vis a vis the existing fees structure for LLB was placed A comparative statement with other law schools was also placed. The University proposes to increase the fees structure of the LL.B. course due to increase in the Library, Information & Technology, and hostel amenities expenditure and also to meet other inflationary costs. In this connection the University proposes a new fees structure with a hike of 6%(Approx).The Executive Council in its meeting dated 19-11-2011 accepted in principle the restructuring of the fees and referred it to the Finance Committee for its report and recommendations.</p> <p>Fees from students are the only major source of revenue to meet the expenses, both for capital and revenue expenditure of the University.</p>	

The Government grants are available only for payment of installments in terms of the bank loan taken for building the University Campus.

The University has also received a Capital grant from the UGC but it has to meet its revenue expenses from the revenue generated from its own resources i.e the student fees etc.

There has been a steady increase in maintenance expenditure over the years due to modern facilities being provided to the students, the earnings at the optimal level can barely meet future expenditure demands. Additionally, due to inflationary pressure as well as increase in expenditure on various activities, the income may not be able to sustain the anticipated demands in future years. It is, therefore, imperative that steps are immediately taken to augment fee-income of the University so that academic activities are not hampered due to paucity of funds.

Whereas attempts are on to secure revenue grants from UGC and other Government sources for specific developmental needs for the next five year plan, the authorities may like to consider a revision of existing fees for the purpose of sustainability and to properly facilitate growth of academic activities in the University. This will also ensure better financial health to facilitate drawing up perspective and forward-looking plans. Moreover, the scheme for grant of need-based freeships out of University's own resources, sponsoring extra circular activities of the student, sponsoring student for moot court participation etc are being implemented in a staggered process.

Hence, there has been no substantial increase in fees payable by students for the LL.M. programme during the past decade. The fees for the LL.M. programme at NUJS is also the least among the contemporary NLU's. Proposed revision of fees structure was placed. The University proposes for a 50 % hike(Approx) in the LLM fees for the new batch of students. The University also is going to introduce a Compensatory teaching or orientation course for 3 weeks as part of the LLM course. The LLM programme will also offer two branches of specialization: 1. Commercial Law 2. International Law. Hence the hike is justified.

RESOLUTION

The Finance Committee directed that the University may consider revision of fees for the forthcoming batch of 2012 of the University because of the following reasons:

- I. For 2012 batch of LLB students:
 - a. During the last two years there has been no increase in the fees but there has been increase in the expenditure of the University due to increase of employee salary which has almost seen a rise of 50%(Approx) during the last two years.

		<p>b. Inflation is also on the rise.</p> <p>c. The Registrar ,Dr.S.C.Mukhopadhyay informed the Finance Committee that during the last CLAT Implementation Committee meeting all the NLU's gave indications that they are planning for a fees revision.</p> <p>d. The Law Schools/Universities who are charging less fees are actually getting financial assistance/aid from their respective State Government's.</p> <p>e. NLS, Bangalore and NLU, Bhopal are already charging more than NUJS.</p> <p>In view , of the reasons stated above the Finance Committee proposes a 6%(Approx) hike of the LLB fees from Rs.148000/- to Rs.155500/-(For candidates other than NRI) and from Rs.298000/- to Rs.318000/-(For NRI Candidates, US \$ 1 = Rs.52/-approx.) for the forthcoming batch of 2012.</p> <p>II. <u>For 2012 batch of LLM students:</u></p> <p>A. During the last two years there has been no increase in the fees but there has been increase in the expenditure of the University due to increase of employee salary which has almost seen a rise of 50 %(Approx) during the last two years.</p> <p>B. Inflation is also on the rise.</p> <p>C. The Registrar ,Dr.S.C.Mukhopadhyay informed the Finance Committee that during the last CLAT Implementation Committee meeting all the NLU's gave indications that they are planning for a fees revision.</p> <p>D. The Law Schools/Universities who are charging less fees are actually getting financial assistance/aid from their respective State Government's.</p> <p>E. NLS, Bangalore and NLU, Bhopal are already charging more than NUJS.</p> <p>F. The University has not proposed a hike in LLM fees during the last seven years.</p> <p>In view , of the reasons stated above the Finance Committee proposes a 49%(Approx) hike of the LLM fees from Rs.41500/- to Rs.62000/-(For candidates other than NRI) and from Rs.71500/- to Rs.108000/-(For NRI Candidates, US \$1=Rs.52/-approx) for the forthcoming batch of 2012.</p> <p>The Finance Committee also referred the matter of revision of fees hike to the Executive Council for its decision.</p>

Procurement of Gowns	<p>The matter arises out of the 35th meeting of the Executive Council dated 30/4/2011.The Executive Council directed that the University may continue the practice of using gowns and hats and also directed that the registration money for the Convocation may be increased in order to ensure repair/replacement of damaged gowns and hats. The University generally hires convocation gowns from M/s Murari Mohan Dutta, Costume supplier . Currently the University while</p>	As directed the matter has accordingly been processed for decision of the Executive Council.

		<p>providing the gowns and other amenities to the student's charges per student in-person Rs. 300/- and in-absentia Rs. 150/-.</p> <p>The University proposes to increase the convocation fees from Rs. 300/- to Rs. 1000/- in-person and Rs. 150/- to Rs. 500/- in absentia.</p> <p><u>RESOLUTION</u></p> <p>The Finance Committee directed that the University may charge Rs.500/- as fees for in person attendance at the Convocation and Rs.150/- for 'in absentia' candidates.</p>	<p>As directed the matter has accordingly been processed.</p>

Research Assistants	<p>Applications for enhancement of the consolidated salary of Research Assistants were received with a request for enhancing the consolidated salary from Rs.10000/- to around Rs.15000/-</p> <p><u>RESOLUTION</u></p> <p>The Finance Committee directed that the application for enhancement of the salary of the Research Assistants may be considered at the time of preparation of the revised budget estimates 2012-13. It directed the University to place the proposal after 31/3/2012 to be considered for the next financial year.</p>

Library fund transfer.

The University has received a request from the University Librarian for converting the fund allocated under 'Books and E resources' of Rs.70.14 Lakhs to Library 'Infrastructure' (Annexure 2 A) since the UGC has allocated Rs. 1 Crore and Thirty Lakhs for procuring books and journals

NOTE

The Budget 2011-12 has earmarked Rs 70.14 lakh to the Library for purchase of 'Books and E-resources', expecting the infrastructure expenses to be met from the forth coming UGC grant. The UGC, in turn, has allocated fund under the same head 'Books and Journals'. The Library is, thus, left with no fund for the urgent expansion it has been planning for long.

The Library Committee considered this issue in its meeting on 24 .11 .11 vide item no. 3 and recommended that:

1. *the fund allocated by the University under 'Books and E-resources' be considered for conversion to 'Infrastructure' immediately on condition that it be reverted back to 'Books and E-Resources' if and when the University can meet the expense from its general fund.*
2. *that the following items be taken up for immediate action from the Infrastructure Fund: 1) Introduction of security system like tattle tape, RFID, 2) Extension of Library to Room Nos. 007, 008 and 009, 3) Construction of a covered external passage from Library to Room No. 1009 and space for open air reading beside the passage, 4) Revamping of Room No. 007, 008, 009, and Journal Section like flooring, lighting, A/C, false ceiling, curtaining etc, (The iron windows be replaced with single, large windows) 5) Furniture for Room No. 007, 008, 009, and Journal Section and miscellaneous library furniture, 6) False ceiling and flooring in Library Hall and 7) Revamping and furnishing of reception and counter area.*

The works should be under taken in consultation with a qualified architect as well a sub-committee where two members from the LC be represented.

Release of Government Grant for the F.Y. 2011-2012

For this F.Y. 2011-2012 we have placed a demand to the State Govt. for Rs. 2,80,00,000/- (Rupees Two Crores Eighty Lacs) only as Grant –in-aid, which is receivable till date.

In the Previous F.Y. 2010-2011, we have received 2,20,50,000/- (Rupees two crores and Twenty Lacs Fifty Thousand) only as Grant-in-aid from the State Govt. However, we have repaid Rs. 2,59,00,000/- (Rupees Two Crores Fifty Nine Lacs) only to the Corporation Bank against our term loan. Hence the shortfall of Rs. 38,50,000/- (Rupees Thirty Eight Lacs Fifty Thousand) only of the F.Y. 2010-2011 is also still receivable from the State Govt. (Annexure 3A).



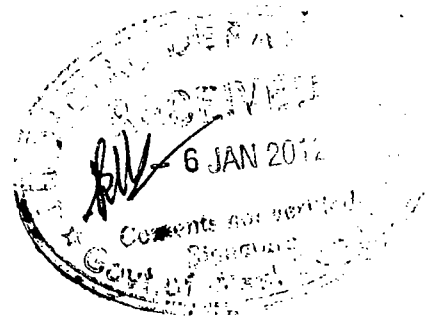



PUBLIC NOTICE

It has come to the notice of the University Grants Commission that Institutions and Universities including institutions deemed to be universities are admitting students to various programmes of studies long before the actual starting of academic session; collecting full fee from the admitted students; and, retaining their schools / institutions leaving certificate in original. The Institutions and Universities are also reportedly confiscating the fee paid if a student fails to join by such dates.

2. The Commission is of the view that the Institutions / Universities, by way of retaining the certificate in original, force retention of admitted students which limits the opportunities for the candidates from exercising other options of joining other institutions of their choice. However, it would not be permissible for Institutions and Universities to retain the School / Institution Leaving Certificate, mark sheet, caste certificate and other documents in original.

3. The Ministry of Human Resource Development and University Grants Commission have considered the issue and decided that the Institutions and Universities, in the public interest, shall maintain a waiting list of students / candidates. In the event of a student / candidate withdrawing before the starting of the course, the waitlisted candidates should be given admission against the vacant seat. The entire fee collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of not more than Rs. 1000/- (one thousand only) shall be refunded and returned by the Institution / University to the student / candidate withdrawing from the programme. Should a student leave after joining the course and if the seat consequently falling vacant has been filled by another candidate by the last date of admission, the Institution must return the fee collected with proportionate deductions of monthly fee and proportionate hostel rent, where applicable.

4. The Universities / Institutions are requested to abide by the instructions issued by the UGC. The UGC, shall on its own or on receipt of specific complaints from those affected, take all such steps as may be necessary to enforce these directions.

5. Institutions / Universities are also required to convey these instructions to the colleges affiliated to them.

As you are aware the West Bengal National University of Juridical Sciences (WBNUJS) is a premier law university which is the pride of this State. The institute is located at 12, L.B. Block, Salt Lake City, Sector III, Kolkata : 700098 and operating since 1999.

This is a residential University having approximately 700 enlisted students and teaching staff of 39. In addition we always have visiting faculty comprising of 1 to 5 professors at a time. Student hostels have a capacity of 500 students which is grossly inadequate to accommodate all the students. No accommodation facility exists for the faculty or other staff including the Vice Chancellor or the guests. There is a dire need for expansion of accommodation facilities, especially for female students.

In June 2009, we had applied (copy enclosed) to the erstwhile government to allot to the University plot of land adjacent to the compound of the university as this would be convenient for expansion of our girls and boys hostel as well as for the Guest House and faculty quarters. This land is surrounded on all sides by educational institutions (map enclosed) in the midst of which a godown of KMDA is located.

Although the erstwhile Government Minister for Urban Development, during his visit to our University promised that at least half of the land occupied by KMDA would be allocated to us, unfortunately the erstwhile government later declined our request. (Copy enclosed).



We would be grateful if you could kindly look into this matter and arrange for allotment of the contiguous land to us for our dire expansion needs.


Dear Sir,

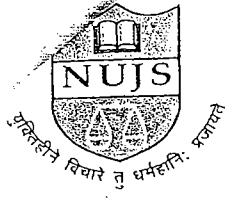

Subject: Allocation of additional land to WBNUJS for its expansion and development.

Hon'ble Shri Bhattacharya,

Please let me have the liberty of writing to you on behalf of the WBNUJS about its pressing need for expansion and development which is impossible unless the University gets additional land in its vicinity.

The existing area allotted is fully built up and WBNUJS is lagging behind the other national law schools in terms of infrastructure.

Sir, permit me to bring to your kind notice that there is a plot of land adjacent to the University compound with almost no construction excepting two long sheds which are currently being used as godowns. From the map enclosed you will find that the plot is surrounded on all four sides by educational institutions – Institute of Fashion Design, WBNUJS, Institute of leather Technology, Jadavpur University and the Jadavpur University hostel. If this plot, measuring about five acres, is made available to the University its requirements for expansion and development in the foreseeable future will be met.

May I please be allowed to bring to your kind notice a brief view of the immediate and urgent expansion and development needs and plans of the University and the suitability of the above plot for ideally meeting them. I enumerate them as follows:



1. The current two hostels one each for boys and girls are inadequate to accommodate present intake of students and we have to either deny them hostel facility or accommodate at odd places. As we cannot accommodate all our current students we cannot increase student intake without building new hostels.
2. The University needs to construct a building for its library.
3. It needs to construct a guest house for visiting faculty and trainees who regularly visit the University for its regular and special programmes.
4. Being a residential University, it needs to provide sports facility for its students.
5. The University currently in its tenth year, needs to house its Vice Chancellor, the Registrar and other academic and administrative staff.
6. Even the class rooms will fall short of its requirements if the University expands, as it is planning to do, in terms of numbers and new courses.
7. The University is also planning to establish a Centre for Advanced Legal Studies in this part of the country with the support of University Grants Commission.
8. The requested plot does not have any solid construction and the purpose for which it is being used at the moment is not congruent with its surroundings. On all four sides of this plot are educational institutions. In view of these educational institutions all around this plot, it is most suitable and appropriate for educational purpose so that the entire area becomes an educational hub in the Salt Lake City of Kolkata. The current godowns may be shifted to a more appropriate place

As the Government of West Bengal has been promoting overall development of education and considers the University as one of its prestigious institutions, we crave your indulgence in accepting our request and let the University utilize the plot for its growth as a centre of excellence.

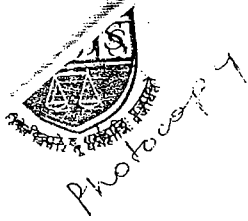


I refer to your letter dated 01.12.2010 regarding allotment of additional land for WBNUJS in the vicinity of its existing campus.

As you are aware the West Bengal National University of Juridical Sciences (WBNUJS) is a premier law university which is the pride of this State.

This is a residential University and the facilities are now chalk – a – block full. There is a dire need for expansion.

The erstwhile Government had, at some point, allotted a plot of land in Rajarhat for expansion.

In June 2009, we had applied (copy enclosed) to the erstwhile government to exchange that land in Rajarhat with the plot of land lying adjacent to the compound of the university as this would be convenient for expansion of our girls and boys hostel as well as Guest House, faculty quarters and quarter for the Vice Chancellor. This land is surrounded on all sides by education institutions (map enclosed) and is partly used as godown by KMDA.
