Moreover it is resolved that a clarification may be taken from the office of the Backward Class Department, Govt. of West Bengal whether for Guest Faculty and Adjunct Faculty there is any Reservation Rules or Notifications being issued by the Government. It is further resolved that a circular letter may be sent to the State Universities/National Universities enquiring whether reservation being followed by them in recruiting Guest or Adjunct faculties.

#### **ACTION TAKEN REPORT**

2. Ratification of the Minutes of the 40<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Academic Council Meeting

It was resolved on 26<sup>th</sup> June 2021, Executive Council Meeting that "the Minutes of the 40<sup>th</sup> Academic Council Meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2021 be placed before the Executive Council after its confirmation by the Academic Council in its subsequent meeting.

In this connection attention of the learned Members is drawn on **Powers & Functions of the Executive Council**, Rule 9(1) and (10) of WBNUJS Act 1995 Schedule where recommendation and consultation with the Academic Council have been mentioned. Rule 9(1) provides that "action shall be taken by the Executive Council in regard to the number, qualifications and emoluments of teachers, after

Duties of all teaching posts shall be as per UGC Guidelines and under WBNUJS Rules and Regulations.

Qualification & Salary : As per the UGC Guidelines issued with 7<sup>th</sup> Pay revision in 2018.

All these posts are to be filled up on contractual basis for 5 years. Posts of Assistant Professor be filled up immediately on contractual basis and the remaining posts would be filled up in the next Academic Year with approval of Roaster from the Department of Backward Classes, Government of West Bengal.

The matter was discussed in the 41<sup>st</sup> Meeting of the Academic Council and the Academic Council

recommended the matter for consideration of the Executive Council for its approval. The proposal for introducing these courses was also placed before the General Council Meeting held on 14/07/2021. From this Academic Year we are admitting additional 40 (forty) LL.M. students from All India CLAT Examinations of which 20 for Criminal and Security Laws and the other 20 on Law and Technology. Similarly we are going to admit 30 students in M.Sc. (Forensic Science) from September 2021. All these Courses are Self-Financing Courses and there will be no extra cost to the University Exchequer. From all these courses approximately Rs. 75,00,000/- (Rupees Seventy Five lakhs ) will be collected as fees and expenditure for payment of salaries of contractual teacher will be approximately Rs. 50,00,000/- (Rupees fifty lakhs only).
