ADMISSIONS TO Ph.D/LL.DDEGREE PROGRAMME-2022

NOTIFICATION No. Acad/PG/06/2022/01DATE: 25-06-2022.

Applications are invited in prescribed proforma for admission to **Ph.D. (Doctor of Philosophy) in Law/Political Science/History/Economics/and Forensic Science**. The last date for submission of the application is 25th July 2022.

Seats- Ph.D. University Junior Research Fellowship (Full time): Two(2)
Ph.D. University Research Scholars: Ten (10) which may be increased,

1. Eligibility criteria for admission to the Ph.D. programme

1.1 The candidate shall have LL.M/M.Sc. degree or any Masters degree having the potentiality of interdisciplinary study from any university recognized by UGC or equivalent LL.M or Masters Degree of foreign university with a minimum of 55% marks or equivalent CGPA.

1.2 However, this condition is relaxed to 50% in case of candidates belonging for those who obtained their Masters degree prior to 10th September 1991.

1.3 The condition is relaxed to 50% in case of candidates belonging to SC and ST/OBC (Non creamy layer) or differently abled categories.

1.4 Candidates who have qualified for UGC NET/SLET/SET/JRF fellowships or having M.Phil. Degrees are exempted from Entrance Test. However, they have to undergo interview.

1.5 Candidates appearing in Final LL.M Examination or Master Degree in respective subject may also apply. Admission is subject to submission of final marks sheets with the requisite percentage of marks.

2) Admission Process for Ph.D. programme

2.1 Admission of candidates under 1.1 above to Ph.D shall be through an Entrance test and interview.

2.2 Admission of candidates under 1.4 above shall be on the basis of interviews only.

SHORTLISTING OF CANDIDATES:

All the applicants have to submit a Research Proposal within 3000 (three thousand) words.

The Proposal shall include- Concept & Introduction; Statement of Problem; Literature Review national/ international; Research gap; Objectives of the Study; Research Questions; Hypothesis (if any); research Methodology; Research Design ; Research Tools; research outcome/significant contribution. On evaluation of the Research Proposals the short listed candidates shall be called for written tests and/or Interview as the case may be. **It may be noted that candidature of those candidates who shall not submit the Research Proposal including the above details shall automatically be rejected.**

3) There will be an Entrance Test consisting of one Research Methodology paper of 1½ hours duration (50 marks) and one Law paper of 2 hours duration (50 marks) for candidates other than point no (1.4.) stated above. The written off-line test will be informed in due course.

The syllabus of the papers shall cover:

Written Exam

The syllabus of the entrance test shall cover 50 marks questions on Research Methodology and other 50 marks from various law subjects or interdisciplinary subjects as the case may be.

Law subjects are- Law of Contract; Constitutional Law; Law of Crimes; Public International Law; Jurisprudence; Company Law; Intellectual Property Law; Information Technology Law.

Separate Exam will be held for Political Science, History, Economics and Forensic Science.

Interview for all qualified candidates will be held on the basis of his/her Research Proposal.

4) Selection of candidates for the available seats shall be on the basis of marks obtained in Research Proposal, entrance test plus interview or Research Proposal and interview only as the case may be on the basis of merit. Date of interview will be notified later on.

5. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION TO THE LL.D. PROGRAMME

5.1 Any candidate who satisfies the following conditions is eligible to seek registration for LL.D. in the University upon application for registration after going through the Regulations and Guidelines for LL.D.

5.2 The candidate shall have Ph.D. Degree in Law from any recognized University.

5.3 The candidate must have published as the main author a minimum of ten articles in SCOPUS/ UGC CARE listed journals or books of repute with ISBN number after the completion of Ph.D.

5.4. The candidate shall submit a Research Proposal which includes- Concept & Introduction; Statement of Problem; Literature Review national/international ; Research gap; Objectives of the Study; Research Questions; Hypothesis (if any); research Methodology; Research Design ; Research Tools; expected outcome; relevant to on policy making/society; innovation; new data to be generated and novelty of the study.

5. REGISTRATION

Application for Registration with prescribed fees shall be submitted to the University along with 2 hard copies and one soft copy of the Research Proposal.

6) FEES for Ph.D/LL.D programme-

Registration fees of Rs. 15,000 (Non-refundable) (at the time of registration) plus annual fees of Rs. 50,000 per annum (Non-refundable).

Admission Notification for 2 years Masters in Forensic Science

Eligibility-

M.Sc. Forensic Science: B.Sc. Pass/Hons. With chemistry/ Biochemistry /Biotechnology/ Microbiology/Anthropology/ Computer Science/ Physics/Botany/ Maths/Forensic Science/Zoology/B.Sc.LL.B or any equivalent degree with minimum of 50% marks.

Note: 5% marks for relaxation of SC/ST candidate for eligibility.

Intake- 30 seats for Post Graduate. Note: Reservation: As per the rule of the State Government/ University.

Duration – M. Sc. Forensic Science: 2 years, Semester system, Minimum 4 Semesters (maximum 4 years to complete the course)

Criteria of Admission – Admission to eligible candidate will be strictly on the basis of merit list to be prepared on the basis of a one hour Written Test of 50 marks and an Interview of 50 marks. The test will be conducted on 7th August 2022 following subjects :-

1. General Awareness 2. Reasoning Test 3. Current Affairs 4. Physical Science 5. Life Science 6. Data Science 7. Concepts of Justice Procedure in India through Forensics. The questions will be asked from Under Graduate level. Candidates appearing in Final Examination may also apply.

Medium of Instruction – English

Fee: - (i) At the time of Admission: Rs. 1,06,000/- (ii) Semester Tuition Fee – Rs. 40,000/- (iii) Refund of fees: Request for refund of fee should be made to the Vice-Chancellor, WBNUJS within one month of deposition of fees. On approval such candidate shall be entitled for refund of 50% of the prescribed fee. Request for refund of fee shall not be considered under any circumstances, if made after one month from the date of deposition of Admission fee by the candidates.

Attendance :- Minimum attendance required to become eligible to appear in the examination for each paper shall be 75% of all class lectures (theory and practical). In case a student is short of attendance due to illness, participation in sports, or other academic events with approval of the University, extra curricular activities, etc. the following rules shall apply.
