Distinguished professionals in the field of alternative dispute resolution were present to adjudicate the rounds, which took place over a period of three jam-packed days. The internals saw participation from over a hundred teams in both categories, making it a tough fight to the top ranks.

The internals were conducted over the process of two rounds with the first round being adjudicated by the 4th and 5th years. 


JOURNAL RELEASES

INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON CLIMATE JUSTICE IN SUNDARBANS

The Legal Aid Society NUJS collaborated with King's College London and Doughty Street Chambers UK for the 6th LAS International Conference in July on legal and extra-legal remedies for Climate Justice in the Sundarbans.

Various important questions based on intersectional problems faced by Sundarbans inhabitants were posed at this two-day conference which is part of an innovative, multi-disciplinary partnership between NUJS & College London (KCL) Human Rights and Environment Law Clinic, Doughty Street Chambers, and Jadavpur University.



HIMMAT PANEL DISCUSSION ON POSH AND ITS EVOLUTION



Himmat held its first ever panel discussion delving into 'PoSH and its evolution over the past decade along with its interplay with themes such as disability, queer representation and technology' on August 6, 2022. The esteemed panel comprised of Miss Nandini Khaitan (Partner at Khaitan & Co.), Miss Jhuma Sen (Advocate of Supreme Court of India and High Court of Calcutta and Adjunct Faculty at NUJS) and Miss Esha Shekhar (Lawyer in SaaS and Data Privacy space).

The discussion was extremely insightful as the three panelists delved into the Anti-sexual harassment law combined with their own personal experiences working with the clients and other such real-life instances and examples.

INAUGURATION OF PRO-BONO CLUB SCHEME

The Pro Bono Club at NUJS, under the aegis of the Ministry of Law and Justice, New Delhi, conducted its first offline panel discussion on "Revisiting Justice – Social, Economic and Political After 75 Years of Independence" on 16th August, as part of the Inauguration of the Pro Bono Club Chapter.

The Panel comprised of Dr. Sanjit Kumar Chakraborty, Dr. Shameek Sen, Mr. Agnidipto Tarafder, Dr. M P Chengappa, and Adv. Sonam Basu, Calcutta High Court with the keynote address by Hon'ble Justice Soumen Sen, Judge, Calcutta High Court. The event saw great attendance with the esteemed panel presenting excellent point of views and ideas.



PACT BOOTCAMP



The ADR Society in association with the Peacekeeping and Conflict Resolution Team ("PACT") organised a two-day Negotiation and Mediation Boot Camp. The two-day course covered theoretical as well as practical aspects of Negotiation and Mediation and also included discussions and interactive practice sessions.

The course was beneficial to anyone seeking to improve their practical skills and/or do well in ADR competitions. Mr. Jonathan Rodrigues, the key speaker and host beautifully explained with demonstrations the nuances of Mediation and Negotiation. A boot camp aims to sharpen the skills of aspiring lawyers; so that they can be transformed into newly trained mediators.

WBNUJS SENSITIZATION PROGRAM FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES



The NUJS Centre for Disability Rights and Equal Opportunities (CDREO) in association with IDIA West Bengal Chapter conducted a Sensitization Program for Persons with Disabilities on 30th August, 2022 in the WBNUJS auditorium with the objective of promoting institutional inclusivity with respect to specially-abled persons and facilitating the realization of their true potential.

In the 1st session, Dr. Rupali Sen, Head of Department (O.T.) and Asst. Professor, National Institute for Locomotor Disabilities discussed the identification & concept of disability with an approach to Rehabilitation. This was followed by, the convener of CRDEO spoke about the WBNUJS Disability Policy 2022 and its crucial provisions. The second and the third sessions were held with speeches by Mr. Biswajit Ghosh, the former Principal of the Ramakrishna Mission Blind Boys Academy Narendrapur and Prof Vijay Kishore Tiwari, the Joint Director of the CDREO and Assistant Professor at NUJS.

SESSION WITH MS. BASWATI MUKHERJEE ON AUGUST 27, 2022






WEEKEND LECTURE SERIES

SESSION WITH MR. ANUBHAV SARKAR ON AUGUST 27, 2022



The 3rd Professor Shamnad Basheer Lecture was organized by LiveLaw and delivered by Justice D.Y. Chandrachud on August 24, 2022. In this lecture, Justice Chandrachud, noting the need for reasonable accommodation, lauded the Shamnad Basheer Accessibility Lab at WBNUJS, which is the first of its kind lab in law schools, and acknowledged the efforts of such a lab in creation of a more conducive environment for students with disabilities.

IP CONFERENCE
