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Plan of Action - 2021-22

With regard to internal quality assurance, the Vice Chancellor is pleased to present the following Plan of Action for the University for the Academic Year 2021-2022:

- It is determined to hold events all through the year for faculty development, a Legal Aid Clinic, conferences, seminars, workshops, and an outreach programme. A small Committee will be formed to oversee.
- Each University Centre is required to host at least five seminars, workshops, or conferences per academic year.
- University alumni, particularly those working in the judiciary, are to be involved with planning advisory programmes for current students. Alumni living abroad should also be sought out for participation in such initiatives which establish alumni networks to nurture long-term relationships between the University and students.
- Collaboration with industry and academia must start for employment prospects and improving the
 employability quotient among the students.
- IPR awareness seminar to be conducted at different levels.
- Online training programme on Mediation to the Consumers Affairs Department, Government of West Bengal, with special reference to Consumer Protection Act 2019.
- Developing course content and assessment strategy on M.Sc. Forensic Science, aligned to the learning objectives.
- Every centre must start with a project and by the end of June each year, each Centre must submit a comprehensive Proposal including all planned activities. After receiving the Centres' full Proposals, the external expert(s) will review them and provide feedback before the programme is finalised.
