CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR RESEARCH POSITIONS IN MINSTRY FUNDED PROJECTS ON CONSUMER LAW

The Centre for Study and Research on Consumer Law (CSRCL) is undertaking research projects funded by various ministries under the Central and State Government which shall aim at carrying out an impact assessment study on implementation of the consumer protection law and functioning of the Commissions. The projects shall entail carrying out empirical research on the focused areas as has been put forth by the Ministries in addition to doctrinal studies including trend analysis of decided cases by the Commissions and literature review of secondary sources. The projects shall range from a span of 3 months to about 1 year.

ABOUT THE OPENINGS

I.RESEARCH ASSISTANT II.INTERN

The research assistant(s) and interns(s) shall work with the Principal Investigator, Co-Investigator and shall liaise with the required government offices, consumer commissions and with other members of the team. The appointment of research assistant(s) shall be given to 26 candidates for an initial period of 6 months and maybe extended based on performance and our requirement. They shall also receive INR 5,000 per month on a consolidated basis. Additionally, travelling and accommodation allowances shall be provided. However, interns shall be taken on a rolling basis for a period of one month and maybe extended based on performance. For students from outside West Bengal, who may be willing to be an intern, CSRCL shall provide them with an opportunity to be a virtual intern.

ELIGIBILITY FOR THE OPENINGS

- i) Essential Qualification: Research Assistant(s) and Intern(s) must be students pursuing 3 years or a 5 years LL.B. course from a recognized university.
- ii) Desirable Qualification: The applicants having publications preferably on issues pertaining to consumer law shall be preferred.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- i)The applicant must submit their CV (maximum 2 pages) and a Statement of Purpose (SOP).
