- W.B. NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF JURIDICAL SCIENCES, KOLKATA (1) ("NUJS"); and
- EBC PUBLISHING PVT. LTD. (company registration no. 7483) whose registered (2) office is at 34A Lalbagh, Lucknow, 226001, UP, India ("EBC").

RECITALS

- NUJS is a deemed university under the West Bengal National University of Juridical (A) Science Act 1999 (West Bengal Act IX of 1999) and imparts legal education. It also publishes the NUJS Law Review.
- EBC publishes books and journals in print, CD-Rom and online formats in India and (B) elsewhere.
- EBC's mission includes the propagation and spreading of Indian legal materials and (C) the encouragement of student initiatives to produce such materials.
- The parties wish to enter into this agreement pursuant to which NUJS shall collect (D) articles, comments, short notes and book reviews etc., edit them and submit them for publication and EBC will take on the responsibility of printing, distributing and selling the NUJS Law Review.

NOW IT IS AGREED

DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

1.1 In this Agreement (save where the context requires otherwise), the following terms and expressions shall have the following meanings:

Editorial Board means the selected student body which generates, controls and manages the content of the Journal and its functioning. It also solely determines the editorial policy which includes content, format, citation-style and other publication related aspects.

Force Majeure Event means any event affecting performance of this Agreement arising from or attributable to acts, events, omission or accidents which are not reasonably foreseeable by, and which are beyond the reasonable control of, a party including without limitation any abnormally inclement weather, flood, lightning, storm, fire, explosion, earthquake, subsidence, structural damage, system failure, epidemic or other natural physical disaster, failure, disruption or shortage of power supplies and/or internet connectivity, war, military operations, riot, crowd disorder, strike, lock-outs or other industrial action, terrorist action, civil commotion and any legislation, regulation, ruling or omissions of any relevant government, court or any competent national or international authority;

Intellectual Property Rights means any and all copyrights, registered design rights, trade marks, trade names, insignia, service marks, semi-conductor topography rights, know how, database rights, patents and all other legal and beneficial intellectual and industrial property rights (whether registered or not) throughout the world no matter by what such rights may be known as in any particular country in the world and all applications for the same;

Issue means one portion of the Journal as published on the Publication date.

NUJS Law Review (hereinafter 'Journal') means:

- (a) The Journal currently in its third year of publication and presently published, distributed and sold by NUJS and managed by its Editorial Board, and
- (b) From its fourth year of publication it shall be a collection of articles, comments, short notes, cases and book reviews, etc. collected, edited and published by the Editorial Board and printed, distributed and sold exclusively in the print medium by EBC at a certain pre-decided periodicity;

Periodicity means the interval between two Publication dates of the Journal and to begin with shall be three months, which period if changed by the Editorial Board shall be informed to EBC in writing;

Opening pages means a set of pages which will be inserted at the end of the last Issue and bound in the beginning of the Volume and shall contain the following information: the Board of Editors, the consolidated table of contents etc.

Publication dates means the dates on which each issue of the Journal shall be deemed to have been published;

Sister Company means, in relation to a company, any of the following: any company which is a Holding Company of that company, a Subsidiary of that company or a company or firm that it owned by the same promoters or managed by the same directors:

Year means a period of twelve calendar months commencing on 01 January in each year of the Term following the Effective Date (as defined in Clause 2);

Royalties means the amounts payable by EBC to NUJS pursuant to Clause 4 and Schedule 1;

Volume means all the issues for one calendar year collated together with an index in either bound or unbound condition.

Term means the duration of this Agreement, as set out in Clause 2.

1.2 All notices, directions and/or instructions which are required to be given or obtained pursuant to this Agreement shall be given in writing (which shall include email provided that all notices provided by email must be confirmed by letter).

2. COMMENCEMENT AND DURATION

The terms and conditions of this Agreement shall come into force on March, 15, 2011 (the "Effective Date") and shall continue indefinitely unless terminated in accordance with Clause 6.

3. CREATION OF NUJS LAW REVIEW

3.1 Obligations and Rights of NUJS

- (a) The Editorial Board of the Journal shall produce and publish each issue of the Journal. NUJS shall continue to remain the publisher of the journal.
- (b) It shall also ensure the content is original and that it does not infringe any Intellectual Property Rights.
- (c) The Editorial Board shall send all the content for the issues of the Journal as per the Publication Schedule so that EBC may bring out the Issues in time for the Publication Date.
- (d) NUJS shall receive Royalty as calculated under Clause 5 and Schedule 1.
- (e) The number of text pages of each issue shall not be less than 128 and shall not exceed 176 pages
- (f) If NUJS decides to bring out a special issue in any year it must inform EBC in writing by October 15 of the previous Year so that EBC can then accordingly change the subscription price and advertise the release of the special issue. In no event can the special issue be cancelled. The special issue will be of a minimum 160 text pages and not exceed 244 text pages.
- (g) NUJS shall indicate EBC as the sole distributor for the Print Edition for the current and subsequent years of the Journal on its website. NUJS shall also link to the subscription page of the Journal on the EBC Webstore site (www.ebcwebstore.com). NUJS shall be free to sell the parts of the Journal for the years 2008-10.
- (h) EBC shall forward any requests received by it for issues of the Journal published prior to the commencement of this Agreement, to an email address designated by the Board of Editors, within a period of Five (5) working days from the receipt of the request. Until instructions to the contrary are intimated to EBC by NUJS, details of the requests shall be forwarded to nujslr@gmail.com.

3.2 Obligations and Rights of EBC

(a) NUJS grants EBC a limited license to carry out its obligations under this agreement. EBC shall be the sole and exclusive distributor of the Journal in the print medium.

- (b) EBC undertakes to make best efforts to market and promote the Journal in Indian and overseas.
- (c) EBC shall typeset, print and distribute the Journal in print. EBC shall maintain the quality of printing of the Journal at present levels and shall ensure that the quality of paper and the quality of the cover paper used is similar in quality to the present printed issues.
- (d) EBC shall also include a set of 'Opening pages' at the end of the last issue to ensure that the Issues can be bound as a Volume.
- (e) EBC shall maintain the Journal's existing subscriber base.
- (f) To propagate and disseminate the content of the Journal, EBC shall, at its own cost and expenditure include the content of the Journal since inception on its databases and shall continue to do till this Agreement is terminated. The parties shall negotiate terms to allow EBC to continue to include the content of the Journal of subsequent Issues on its databases.

- (h) EBC shall include its logo on the cover page of the Issue, the first page of the Issue and on the cover of the Volume subject to the approval from the Editorial Board on maintaining the aesthetic appeal of the Journal.
- (i) The entire risk of printing, distribution, selling and collection of monies shall lie on EBC and in no way will EBC involve NUJS in any dispute regarding the same.
- (j) EBC shall list NUJS as one of its partners and link to a web page so designated by NUJS.

4. COMPLIMENTARY AND PAID SUBSCRIPTIONS

4.1 NUJS shall receive 10 complimentary subscriptions each year. Each contributor shall receive 10 off-Prints for each contribution. NUJS can purchase additional subscriptions at 50% discount on the printed price set for Individual customers.

NUJS shall purchase a minimum 100 subscriptions at the above price atleast for 2011, 2012 and 2013. Post 2013 NUJS shall indicate its requirement to EBC who shall supply the same at the above mentioned price.

5. ROYALTIES

- 5.1 EBC shall pay the Royalties to NUJS on a yearly basis in arrears. If required EBC shall deduct TDS on the Royalty payable.
- 5.2 EBC shall on a yearly basis provide NUJS with a Statement of Royalties payable

- No royalties shall be payable in respect of free/complimentary/sample copies given to NUJS or any organisation by EBC and this will be limited to a total of 20 subscriptions every year.
- 5.5 No royalties shall be payable in respect of paid copies purchased by NUJS.
- 5.6 The Royalties in respect of each Year shall be determined in accordance with Schedule 1.
- 5.7 EBC shall pay the Royalties in respect of each Year to NUJS within 45 days after the end of the Year.
- 5.8 The Royalties shall be payable (at EBC's cost) by cheque or electronic transfer to such bank account as NUJS shall notify to EBC from time to time.

6. TERMINATION

- 6.1 Either party may (without prejudice to its other rights) terminate this Agreement forthwith by written notice to the other if:
