Within the framework of the regulations applying in each Institute, and subject to the availability of resources, the following programs and activities will be encouraged:


Making of IPR Policy by the MHRD IP Chair

2. Formation of IP Cell

The establishment of IP cell will help in IPR related process. Moreover, it will benefit the students to write articles and blogs related to IPR and publish it in different national and international journals.

3. Formation of guidelines & processes of IPR for Institute

The formation of guidelines and process will guide the Institute to follow the protocols and to uphold with rule and regulations

4. Help to set up

a. Entity Incorporation

The setting up Section 8 Entity under the Indian Company Act with Memorandum and objects set by Ministry of Human Resources (It is not for profit organization for Innovations Incubation Start-ups and Entrepreneurship – collectively referred to as centre of Excellence) And out services also including filling of Trademarks based on the section 8 incorporated entity.

b. Centre for Excellence

The centre of excellence for the consultancy in establishing and writing guidelines on Centre of Excellence Incubation Cell and Innovation Centre.

c. Innovation Program

The Innovative program will help in setting up of a workflow of Filter Committees. Invention Disclosure Form (IDF) to capture new ideas, an IPR cell and Patent Program for the Institution.

5. Legal Vetting Process

This process will setup process and policy of selection of new entrepreneurship ideas, Research papers for publication by the student and faculties for entrepreneurship and filing patents.

6. Knowledge Workshops

The experience faculties and industry leaders will conduct knowledge Workshops / Training on various subjects of Intellectual Property Rights and Cyber Law Patents and Engineering Laws.

7. Online Courses

The online courses will provide online access to all students for courses on Intellectual Property Rights , Engineering Law , and / or Cyber Laws, as on the time University will launch the courses after due approval from the University authority.

8. Skill Development Centre

The specific areas and details of cooperation within the framework of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) shall be discussed and agreed upon in writing by the appropriate authority of each Institute, prior to the initiation of any particular program or activity. No binding agreement between the Institutes shall exist unless and until such a formal written agreement is executed.

9. Consultancy charges

The advisory and the consultancy charges will be paid to the University on the mutually agreed amount on the specific assignment with a specific agreement.

The Institutes acknowledge that in the absence of any specific agreement to the contrary, all expenses of salary, travel, living and allied costs will be determined at the discretion and be the responsibility of the visitor's home Institute.

This MOU is a statement of intention between the Institutes in relation to the areas of cooperation set out above. With the exception of the confidentiality obligations set out below, the Institutes do not intend for this to be legally binding.

Whilst this MOU creates no binding obligations on the Institutes, the MOU shall become effective from the date of the last signature and remain in force for a period of five (5) years with the understanding that it may be terminated by either Institute at any time by written notice to the other Institute (but the confidentiality obligations shall remain). Withdrawal from this MOU shall not affect any formal binding agreements already in place between the Institutes in relation to a specific program or

The Institutes shall ensure that they keep all discussions and all information received by the other Institute in relation to this MOU or a proposed program or activity confidential, and not disclose the content of the discussions, or any proposed program or activity, to any third party.

The MoU would be in force from the 18th day of August of year 2020.
