Action Taken Report - 2023-24

The Vice Chancellor is pleased to present the following Action Taken Report with regard to the Plan of Action for the Academic Year 2023-2024:

- 1. Faculty Exchange Program Implementation: The faculty exchange program modalities have been finalized and initiated. Several faculty members participated in international exchange programs enhancing their academic expertise and bringing diverse perspectives back to the university.
- **2. Formation of the IQAC Students Wing:** Mr. Kavan Patel, President of the Student Juridical Association, successfully submitted the names of the representatives from each batch, and the IQAC Students Wing has been actively involved in quality assurance processes throughout the academic year.
- **3. Workshops on Civil and Judicial Services:** Two workshops were conducted during the Monsoon and Winter semesters, focusing on career paths in civil and judicial services. These were led by Dr. Sarfaraz Ahmed Khan and Dr. Shameek Sen, and received positive feedback from participants.
- **4. Establishment of the University Innovation Cell:** The IPR Innovation Cell was established as scheduled, fostering an environment of innovation and guiding faculty and students in intellectual property management.

- **5. Progress in Joint Research Projects:** Continued support and monitoring of joint collaborative research projects have led to significant academic outputs and publications in esteemed journals.
- **6. Faculty Recognition and Incentives:** The revised policy for recognizing faculty achievements has been implemented, with several faculty members receiving incentives for their national and international recognitions.
- **7. Faculty Development Programme:** The Faculty Development Programme on 'Quantitative Techniques & Statistical Methods' was conducted successfully in the last week of June 2024, enhancing faculty skills in research methodologies.
- **8.** Launch of the Incubation Centre: The Incubation Centre was launched, and in collaboration with Leicester University, U.K., it has started developing skills in Alternative Dispute Resolution among students and faculty.
