# CALL FOR ABSTRACTS AND APPLICATION PROCEDURE

NATIONAL UNIVERSITY

Interested applicants are required to send the necessary details by email to phdresearchers.nlus@nujs.edu by 12th April 2025.

The applicants must upload -

- 1. Recent Curriculum Vitae
- 2. Research Proposal (within 3,000 words)
- 3. Letter of Recommendation/ Nomination from the respective Vice Chancellor, where the PhD. Scholar is enrolled.

The selected applicants shall be notified by 16th April 2025. Selected participants will be intimated through mail and they have to process registration through a link where payment details will be provided. The deadline for Registration is between 16th - 21st April, 2025.

#### **REGISTRATION FEES**

Rs. 4000/- (Registration Fees include workshop kit, lunch, accommodation in guest house, refreshments and one day Kolkata City Tour). The University will provide free accommodation in Guest house on a twin/triple sharing basis.
