Implementation of decision of Executive Council regarding Upgradation of the post of PA to Vice Chancellor to Secretary to VC

The proposal of upgradation of the post of Personal Assistant (PA) to Vice Chancellor as Secretary to Vice Chancellor, as recommended by Administrative Audit of the University was placed in the 90<sup>th</sup> Executive Council Meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2023. The Executive Council has approved the proposal as recommended by the Administrative Audit of the University. However, it has directed to place the relevant scale of pay for the post of Secretary along with fixation of pay in the subsequent Executive Council meeting for finalization and implementation.

Accordingly, a pay fixation committee was constituted with the following members by the Vice Chancellor.

ii. Accounts Officer, WBNUJS

iii. Assistant Registrar, IIEST, Shibpur

#### Annexure-

The Committee in its report, stated that since there is no existing Recruitment Rules for Non- Teaching staff in the University, the Model Recruitment Rules as prescribed by the UGC for various Universities was considered for pay fixation. Copy of the UGC Model Recruitment Rules is enclosed in Annexure-

As per the UGC Model Recruitment Rules, the Pay level for Private Secretary is Pay Level 7 and the same may be awarded to the said post. However, it was observed by the Committee that the incumbent staff is already drawing her salary in the Pay Level 7 due to MACP. Therefore, no upgradation of scale of pay will be available. Therefore, direction is sought for whether one increment be approved w.e.f. July 2023 or she may be given Promotion in the next scale of pay as personal to her.

Meanwhile, a committee may be formed for formulating appropriate Promotional policy and appropriate pay scale for the non-Teaching staff of the University.

### Resolution

The Council after threadbare discussion, resolved to approve the proposal of upgradation of the post of Personal Assistant to the Vice Chancellor to the post of Secretary to the Vice Chancellor upon acceptance of the recommendation of the Pay Fixation Committee, without any financial benefits.

The Executive Council also resolved to constitute a committee to formulate Promotion Policy for the Non-teaching staff. The Vice Chancellor is authorized to nominate the members of such Committee within ten (10) days, with the Registrar as Secretary. The names of members of the proposed Committee shall be circulated among the Council members giving 7 days' time for confirmation by the members and if no response is received, the constitution of the Committee shall be deemed to be approved.

Re-advertisement of faculty vacant posts

The draft advertisement to be published was submitted to the Backward Caste Commission, Government of West Bengal on 10-08-2023 for vetting as per the reservation roster and the department has duly acknowledged the reservation roster and no further comments was received on the said matter as on date. Annexure-

Accordingly, the University has made advertisements on 07-09-2023 in leading newspapers for the first time. However, due to inadequate applicants under various reserved category the 93<sup>rd</sup> Executive Council Meeting held on 21<sup>st</sup> December, 2023 has resolved to readvertise the posts under reserved category.

The reserved posts were readvertised again on 17.01.2024 for the second time in various leading newspapers. However, except in two categories namely OBC-B for subject specialization in Criminal Law and SC for subject specialization in Business Law, no adequate applications in other categories were received. The status was reported in the 95th Executive Council Meeting held on 28th May, 2024 and the Executive Council has directed again to readvertise the remaining reserved posts.

Therefore, on 20.08.2024 it was again readvertised for the third time in leading newspapers such as Ananda Bazar Patrika, Bartaman, Times of India, Pratidin and The Statesman.

# Resolution

It is reported that despite three attempts made by the University through open advertisements in various leading newspapers dated 07.09.2023, 17.01.2024 & 20.08.2024 to fill up the teaching posts reserved for Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled

Tribe (ST) and Other Backward Class (OBC - A & B) as per the order of the Backward Classes Welfare Department, Govt. of West Bengal, the said posts could not be filled up.

The Council had a threadbare discussion in the matter and it was resolved to seek permission from the Backward Classes Welfare Department, Government of West Bengal for de-reservation of the reserved posts which were advertised and for which sufficient number of applications were not received.

In terms of provisions contained in clauses 9 and 10 of office memo no. 1471, 1472 & 1473 /BCW.MRD-03/2021 dated 27/05/2022 issued by the Backward Classes Welfare Department, Government of West Bengal, the Registrar shall furnish appropriate undertaking.

8 Creation and fixation of remuneration for Professor of Practice

The creation of Professor of Practice (PoP) posts in the University was approved by the Executive Council in its 90<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2023 based on the recommendation of 46<sup>th</sup> Academic Council Meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> May, 2023.

However, the composition of Selection Committee for Professor of Practice and applicable remuneration was not finalized in the said Meeting and left to Vice Chancellor for recommendation considering other practices in different institutions such as IIMs, IITs, IIFT and NLU Delhi.

# The composition of selection committee for Professor of Practice

The Vice Chancellor has proposed that, the composition of selection committee shall be as per applicable University rules and regulations for selection of regular Professor position in the University and the remuneration will be in the range of Rs. 1 lakh to Rs. 2 lakhs depending on the experience and expertise of the candidate and in deserving cases the selection committee may propose according to the industry norms to attract exceptional applicant for the post of Professor of Practice.

The selection of Professor of practice will be same as provided in WBNUJS Act 1999. Comparing with the

#### Researchers: -

As per recommendation of the Academic Council in its 49<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 04.07.2024 the Ph.D. Research Scholars/JRF/Research Fellows will be provided financial assistance in the following manner;

a. **For International Conference-** Upto Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty Thousand) only once in whole of the research period.

b. **National Conference-** Upto 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) only in whole of the research period.

Selection of Conferences in which Teachers and Researchers will be entitled shall be decided by the Vice-Chancellor and a list to be prepared for approval from time to time.

# Resolution

The Council discussed the proposal of financial assistance to teachers and resolved that the financial assistance for teachers attending the International Conferences shall be up to Rs. 1,00,000/ and Rs. 30,000/ for National conference for every financial year. The assistance shall include the reimbursement of economy class Airfare, actual boarding and lodging expenses, registration fees and local conveyances.

For the Researchers'/JRF/URF/Research Fellows, the ceiling will be Rs. 50,000/ for International Conference and Rs. 20,000/ for attending National conference. The assistance is only once in the whole of research tenure.

Further resolved that, the eligibility and entitlement to participate in the International Conferences and National conference shall be decided by the Vice Chancellor primarily considering the benefits that would accrue to the students and the University.

# Payment of Gratuity without Dearness Allowance

It may be noted that, as per section 37 of University Regulation towards Contributory Provident Fund -cum-Gratuity Scheme, the amount of Gratuity at the time of relinquishing service of the University will mean only Basic Pay and it will not include special pay, personal pay, and other emoluments as pay.

Therefore, his Gratuity was computed based on his last Basic Pay and the Gratuity amount of Rs.7,42,500/-was paid to him on 19.06.2024 as stated in the above table which was also verified by the Internal Auditor of the University.

Meanwhile, on receipt of the same, he has submitted an appeal for payment of Dearness Allowances as part of Gratuity components which has not been paid to him and he has also quoted the rules of NUJS Contributory Provident cum Gratuity Rules as sated in the foot note (1) of sub section 6 of section 12.

However, the NUJS Regulations towards Contributory Provident Fund -cum-Gratuity Scheme stipulates that the amount of Gratuity at the time of relinquishing service of the University will mean only Basic Pay and it will not include special pay, personal pay, and other emoluments as pay.

It may be noted that, as per section 22 of Schedules to the WBNUJS Act, 1999 for Provident fund, gratuity,

pension and other benefit scheme "All permanent employees of the University shall be entitled to the benefit of the provident fund and gratuity in accordance with such regulations as may be made in that behalf by the Executive Council".

Therefore, under WBNUJS Regulations the amount of Gratuity needs to be computed only on Basic Pay, whereas the NUJS Contributory Provident Fund cum Gratuity Rules in it 'foot note' 1 state that 'for the purpose of the rules relating to gratuity, emoluments include Dearness Pay and Dearness Allowance over pay receivable on the date of retirement/death'.

Further, in case of Settlement of Dispute with regard to quantum and share of gratuity the said NUJS Contributory Provident Fund cum Gratuity Rules states that, "shall be referred to the Executive Council of the University, whose decision, to be recorded, shall be final and binding on all concerned".

Hence, the matter is referred to the Executive Council for appropriate decision with regard to inclusion of Dearness Allowance for computation of Gratuity.

On 15<sup>th</sup> July, 2024 the Vice Chancellor through email communicated him that "The matter will be placed before the Finance Committee and the Executive Committee for necessary clarification and directions and Mr. Tapash Bhattacharya is requested to wait for the clarifications of the competent authority and not to write any email or letter on this issue till the said decision /clarifications".

However, he has started complaining to the CJI and Chancellor of the University and other Members of Executive Council by stating that he was ill-treated and Harassed by the University Authorities on regular basis. His emails from June, 2024 to till 23<sup>rd</sup> September, 2024 is enclosed.

The 49th Academic Council Meeting held on 4th July, 2024 has approved the Post Graduate Course of M.A. in Criminology and Criminal Justice Administration along with the Course outline/syllabus structure with preliminary guidelines for MA in Criminology and to introduce the Course, if possible, from January 2025 or July 2025.

It may be noted that to introduce this Course there is no need to create new posts. We have already created three (3) posts in Criminology for the BSc. LL.B. Criminology and Forensic Science which was introduced in the academic year 2023-24. Moreover, 2 (Two) Assistant Professor posts are now proposed to be converted as specialization in Criminology as per the recommendations of the Academic Council Meeting held on 4th July, 2024. Thus, BSc LL.B. as well as M.A. in Criminology courses can be covered by these 5 (five) teachers. It may be mentioned here that in whole eastern part of India no University has introduced the post graduate course in the said subject.
