#### Resolution:

The Executive Council has noted the joining report of the faculties who got CAS promotion. The council has further directed that in future the process of CAS promotions be initiated well in advance as per UGC guidelines.

Issues of prayer for further lien and the letter by the Registrar to join by 10th of November, 2024 and to consider the resignation letter received from Prof. Manoj Kumar Sinha.

Prof. Manoj Kumar Sinha who was on Lien from the University since August 2013 to 31st July, 2018 and again from 1st August 2018 to 31st August, 2023 & further another period up to January, 2024, has applied for extension of his Lien period for a further tenure of 5 years till 2029 and the same was referred in the 96th Executive Council Meeting held on 5th October, 2024. The note in this regard as placed in the last meeting is placed in Annexure-4A.

The Executive Council upon perusal of the papers unanimously resolved that the Registrar of the University shall communicate with Dr. Manoj Sinha, requesting him to confirm whether he wishes to resume his duty as Professor of the University by November 10,

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2024. Further, in case Dr. Sinha fails to respond or resume his duty by the specified date, it will be presumed that he is no longer interested in continuing as a Professor of the University. Consequently, there shall be severance of relationship of Dr. Sinha with the University and the post may be declared vacant whereupon, the University will proceed to fill up the said post of Professor in accordance with the University Act and Regulations.

Accordingly, the Registrar has sent a letter on 17<sup>th</sup> October, 2024 Copy of the Letter sent to Prof. Sinha is enclosed in Annexure- 4B.

However, on 31st October, 2024 Prof. Manoj Kumar Sinha has submitted his resignation letter, copy of the resignation letter is enclosed in Annexure-4C

The resignation may be accepted as prayed for.

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		2024 and However, the Hon'ble High Court has dismissed the review petition by an order dated on 18 <sup>th</sup> October, 2024.  The Opinion of the advocate is to make an appeal before the Division Bench of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi.  The copy of the order dated 18 <sup>th</sup> October, 2024 and draft appeal petition is enclosed in Annexure-5B.  Submitted for further directions in this regard.

#### Resolution:

The Council has considered recommendation of the Academic Council at it's meeting held on 19-12-2024 and approved all the listed MoUs placed before the Executive Council. Further resolved that in future the University shall send all the proposed MoUs to Government of West Bengal, Department of Legal Remembrancer with a request to send back the vetted MoUs within a period of fifteen days. The Law Officer of the University will coordinate the process.

7 To discuss representations received from the Mr. Tapas Bhattacharyya, Former Assistant Registrar (Academic) regarding payment of Gratuity.

The University has paid retirement benefits to the tune of Rs. 76,00,484/- which Provident Fund -cum-Gratuity & Leave Salary to Mr. Tapas Bhattacharyya. However, Bhattacharyya has claimed as Contributory Provident Fund -cum-Gratuity Rules.

The matter was placed before the 96th Executive Council Meeting held on 5th October, 2024, the Council upon perusal of all the relevant documents placed in the meeting and discussion on the matter resolved to defer the matter for further consideration in the next Executive Council meeting. Meanwhile, the Registrar was directed to place all the relevant documents pertaining to the Payment of Gratuity including any documents placed before the State Legislature for amendment of the NUJS Act/Rules/Regulations and to inform the retired officer the decision of the Council.

Accordingly, the decision of the Council communicated to the retired officer on 18th October, 2024 and copy of the same is enclosed in Annexure-

Meanwhile, Law Department, Government of West

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Bengal vide letter no. dated 22.10.2024 has stated that "it appears that sub-section (2) of section 8 of the Provident Fund Act, 1925 has not been complied with in making the NUJS Contributory Provident Fund cum Gratuity Rules, as no direction, by way of notification in the Official Gazette, as required, appears to have been issued by the appropriate Government." Copy of the Letter dated 22.10.2024 is enclosed in Annexure-

Section 8 (2) of Provident Fund Act, 1925 states that "The appropriate Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, direct that the provisions of this Act shall apply to any Provident Fund established for the benefit of the employees of any of the institutions specified in the Schedule, or of any group of such institutions, and, on the making of such declaration, this Act shall apply accordingly, as if such Provident Fund were a Government Provident Fund and the authority having custody of the Fund were the Government." Copy of the section of PF Act, 1925 is enclosed in Annexure-

The full list of Institutions as declared by various appropriate authorities as per the said section of the Provident Fund Act, 1925 is enclosed in Annexure-7D for ready reference.

Further, it may also note that as per WBNUJS Act, 1999 vide clause no 13 (4) "All regulations made by the Executive Council shall be submitted, as soon as may be for approval, to the Chancellor and to the General Council at its next meeting, and the General Council shall have by a resolution passed by a majority of not less than two-thirds of the members present, the power to cancel any regulations made by the Executive Council and such regulations shall, from the date of such resolution, cease to have effect". Annexure-

In the instant case, as per available records it is unable to find any such approval was taken from the General Council of the University and also as confirmed by the Law Department no such Official Gazette is available with the State Government.

Hence, the matter is placed for appropriate directions.

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#### Resolution:

The Executive Council has perused the letter of intimation by the Law Department, Government of West Bengal with regard to "NUJS Contributory Provident Fund cum Gratuity Rules" and noted that said Rules was not placed before the appropriate Government for official Notification as per section 8 (2) of the Provident Fund Act, 1925.

The Council also deliberated other applicable provisions of Provident Fund schemes for the University including Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972.

Upon threadbare discussion the Council has deferred the matter and directed the Registrar to place all the relevant documents for further consideration. Meanwhile, the Council directed to place the Gratuity computation of Mr. Tapash Bhattacharya, Ex-Official of the University, with and without application of Dearness Allowance on the Gratuity in the next meeting.

Final Report with regard to the issues of Non-settlement of Accounts of UGC Grants for setting up of Computer Centre in WBNUJS

The matter was referred in the 91st Executive Council Meeting held on 17th September, 2023 and the Executive Council has resolved to conduct a preliminary enquiry by the Principal Secretary, Department of Law, Government of West Bengal and Ex-Officio Member of the Executive Council and Registrar of NUJS will assist him.

The Hon'ble Member has submitted his final report on the matter with observations. The copy of report is enclosed in Annexure- .

The conclusion of the Report stated below:

"The Undersigned is of the opinion that UGC claimed the refund rightly and WBNUJS was bound to make such payment. Thus, a correct decision was taken in 93<sup>rd</sup> Meeting of E.C. on 27.11.2023 and 21.12.2023 for refund of the money amounting to Rs. 13,86,669/- and if the money has been properly refunded back to UGC then the interest, if any, cannot be claimed by UGC with

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effect from the date of such refund".

It may be noted that as per Income Tax Act, 1961 Section 11 (2), the University needs to spend 85% of the surplus accumulation within five years from the financial year in which Form 10 filled. date filling for the objective of the University – Copy of the Income Tax Rule is enclosed in Annexure-

Accordingly, University has filled Form No. 10 for the Financial year 2023-24, therefore, the 85% of accumulated surplus to the tune of Rs.1697.90 lakhs need to be utilized within the financial year 2028-29. Copy of Form 10 of Income Tax is enclosed in Annexure-

Hence, an amount Rs. 1697.90 has been considered in the Revised Budget for 2024-25 and proposed Budget for 2025-26. as applicable.
